

He is also the president of the board of trustees of oikos.

donor collaborative that strives to transform our economic system so that it values ecological integrity and human wellbeing. Prior to launching P4NE, Leslie enjoyed 17 years at the OAK Foundation, where she managed select global climate change portfolios as well as its early marine conservation portfolio.
